The Board of Christian Education Diocese of Colombo – 32nd Annual Meeting 2020-2021 Annual Report

Introduction

It is a great pleasure to present the *32nd Annual Report* of the church of Ceylon Board of Christian Education, Diocese of Colombo. We are thankful to God Almighty for the guidance and strength that we received during this very challenging year due to the COVID pandemic. We appreciate the cooperation we received from the Executive Committee and the Central Board in the past year. A special thanks to the Rt. Rev. Dhiloraj Canagasabey Bishop Emeritus of Colombo. We warmly welcome the 16th Bishop of the Diocese of Colombo Rt. Revd. Dushantha Rodrigo and appreciate the guidance that we have received from him during the past few months. We remember and appreciate all the Clergy Persons, Sunday school Secretaries and the teachers.

The Board of Christian Education is the body which carries out the responsibilities connected with the Sunday school Education of the Diocese of Colombo. The Board closely works with the Diocese of Kurunagala, other denominations which comes under the National Christian Council and with many Christian Organizations.

Vision: To see a community of mature Christians and share the love of Jesus Christ with all.

Mission: To guide and nourish our community to become mature and whole in Christ.

Objectives: To nurture and nourish children in the Christian faith

To empower children to be faithful disciples of Jesus Christ

To foster the growth of Christian Education

To coordinate and evaluate the work of the Board of Christian Education

Achievements:

We sadly state that we were not able to achieve the set goals for the year 2020/2021 due to the COVID pandemic. The programmes that we carried out throughout the year gathering people were limited to only 09 programmes for teachers, children and Parents and 08 sessions of Premarital Counseling were completed as well. We were able to meet 240 children and 333 adults. 15 Clergy Persons joined the events as well. The following are a few achievements other than the programmes held during the year.

a) Since we couldn't meet our Sunday school children physically, we were able to prepare video clips for children aged 3-11 years from the 2nd week of May 2020 and circulated them among the Sunday school secretaries, so that they could share the videos with the relevant teachers.

From the last week of November 2020 we prepared video clips for the children aged 12- 18 years, and circulated them as well. All together we have done 210 video clips weekly in all three languages from the 12th of May 2020 to the 31st of March 2021.

- b) As we didn't get an opportunity to meet with the children of the respective Churches, teachers were equipped with online Sunday School Lesson Work Sheets.
- c) We prepared 537 Work Sheets for grades 04 to 09 in all three languages according to the New Sunday School Syllabus of the National Christian Council. 564 Work Sheets for grades 4 to 11 according to the School Christianity Text Books and 156 model question papers in all three languages for the children in the Ordinary Level classes.
- d) We have conducted 04 Webinars for the Ordinary Level Students in all three languages and a total number 257 children participated.
- e) We were able to enrich and equip the resource persons of the Board by conducting 02 Webinars for them. The first session was conducted by Rev. S. Balasundaram on The 5 marks of Anglican Mission and second session was conducted by Rev. Cannon Joshua Ratnam on Spiritual Formation of a Christian worker.
- f) As we plan to identify more Clergy Persons to conduct Pre-marital Counselling Sessions in the regions, we conducted a foundation session on Premarital Counselling for the Clergy of the Diocese of Colombo. 23 Clergy participated at this trainings and we will be organizing Residential Trainings for them in the future.
- g) We initiated on encouraging the children in reading the Bible and shared 4250 Bible reading Charts among the children and requested them to complete the readings and return the charts to us as we wanted to reward them for their efforts. (As we received only 20 charts in return, or the second and third round of bible reading charts, we simply circulated the charts via digital format.)
- h) Most of the Churches organized spiritual uplifting programmes for the Sunday School Teachers of their church. We were not able to have the dedication services at every church this year as the number of participation at church services were limited.
- i) We introduced the New Sunday school curriculum prepared by the National Christian Council in all three languages and gave our fullest support to them to selling their books.
- j) Though that we couldn't meet the Sunday school teachers and train and equip them during the year, we were able to encourage them to pray by sharing WhatsApp messages through the Sunday School Secretaries.
- k) We joined in the work carried out by the Commission for Environment and Medical Ethics and the Prayer Ministry of the Diocese of Colombo during the Locked down Period.
- I) We were able to work closely with the National Christian Council, Scripture Union and Bible Society and other denominations with union in Christ.

Programmes for the Children

Objective

To make them more interested in their Spiritual Journey by attending Sunday school and helping them grow closer to God Almighty and become disciples of Jesus Christ.

Programme: 04 One day Programmes for the children

We were able to meet 240 children at different programmes conducted by the Board. We have conducted three day Programme for children and Parents, and one programme for the children at Paynters Home Nuwara Eliya. No residential programmes were conducted for the children of the Diocese this year due to the pandemic.

Assessments

- 1. Learnt new things. A days' programme is not enough. We need at least 3 days
- 2. Learnt new songs and enjoyed a time of games.
- 3. I learn how to overcome peer pressure and the challenges I face as a youth.

Programmes for Parents

Objective: Encourage Parents in sending their Children to Sunday Schools, make them aware of the holistic development of Children and how to make their homes a safe and loving environment.

Programme: 03 One Day Programmes for the Sunday school Children and their Parents.

We have conducted 02 One day Programmes for the Parents of Sunday School children to motivate them on the importance of the Sunday School Ministry. We wanted to meet with the parents during a programme for their children so that we would be able to build up a relationship with them as well.

Assessments

- 1. Very happy to join this day. We leant new things and thank you for making us aware of parenting.
- 2. Do not limit these programme just for one day make it at least for two days.
- 3. Simply explained the importance of parenthood. I felt special empathy for the children.

Pre-marital Counseling

Objective: To prepare Young Couples to lead faithful and fruitful married lives as disciples of Jesus Christ.

Programme: Pre Marital counselling sessions

14 young couples participated in Pre-marital counselling sessions and the participants realised the importance of these sessions. As we too have realized the same when we go through the evaluations

written by participants, have decided to train more Clergy Persons to address young couples before marriage. We encourage all Clergy Persons to send couples for the sessions that are conducted by the Board on every 4th Saturdays of the month in all three languages, even though they might be conducting their own sessions for the couples. (The participants should register prior to the date)

Assessments

- 1. Have more time for the session and give more practical explanations.
- 2. It is better if a doctor could attend the session on the medical perspective of marriage.
- Helped us to understand the challenges of the married life and how to overcome them with God.

Resource Persons Training

Objective: To prepare and enhance the facilitators of the Board.

Programme: Training for Trainers

We have conducted 2 Webinars for the Resource Persons of the Board in a mean to keep in touch with them and to better equip them for the future. 39 resource persons participated.

Online Education Tools

Giving all honour and glory to God, we would like to recognize and admire the commitment made by the video presenters. Especially Ms. Thehani Mendis and her daughter Aheli, Ms. Esther Jansen Hathurusinghe and Miss Jeroni Arulrajah who have given their fullest commitment to prepare video clips without fail from the beginning of this project. Each person has done 46 video clips within the year. The presenters who prepared video clips for the older age group too had been giving their fullest cooperation towards this ministry. We appreciate Rashmi Devraj, Salome Vincent, Malika De Mel, Melissa Hoole, Joseph Jeevanantham, Jayanthi Winston, Ashani John, Saranya Samuel, Inakshi De Silva, Mitchelle Peiris, Keshini Perumal, Rashmi John and Aruni Ferdinando. If we consider the Christian organizations in Sri Lanka or any other country that produces online Sunday school lessons or video clips, it may be difficult to find an organization which has been doing this consistently for over a year according to a syllabus.

Free Bible Story Book

We received 2100 copies of Bible Story Books which were written by Ms. Lakshani Fernando, the former General Secretary of the Bible Society. The target readers are children aged 7 to 13 years. According to her, this project was undertaken by her, so that would be able to share the word of God among the children in a creative manner. These books were printed bilingually, in English, Sinhala and Tamil. We were able to distribute them among the children through the Parish Priests. We appreciate the generosity of Ms. Lakshani Fernando and pray and remember all the donors who contributed towards this ministry.

Our Strengths

We appreciate the guidance and blessing that we received from the Rt. Revd. Dushantha Rodrigo during this very challenging year. We sincerely appreciate the leadership we received from the Rt. Revd. Dhiloraj Canagasabey Bishop Emeritus within the past 09 years. We also thank Ven. Perry Brohier Chairperson of the Board and the members of the Executive Committee and the Central Board for their enormous support. We would like to share our special appreciation with the Mission Secretary Rev. S. Balasundaram who gave his fullest cooperation to the Board. The cooperation received from the Secretary of the Diocese Mr. Arun Gamalathge and the other stakeholders and colleagues of the Diocesan office and Bishop's Office are much appreciated.

We remember the Resource Persons and Volunteers of the Board with great gratitude, who shares their time, skills and knowledge for the benefit of the Board. The commitment that they bring towards the work of the Board is immeasurable. They are always ready to lend a helping hand in difficult times and travel through the Diocese whenever we need their support to spread the word

Finance

- We are pleased to say that the total income of Rs. 3,357,621. 00 for the year 2020/2021 has been contributed by the Diocese of Colombo, Local Churches, participants, and Local wellwishers.
- As the pledge account was implemented for a short period of time, we have now destroyed the balance Pledge forms with the consent of the Executive Committee and the Central Board. Only one donor will be continuing the annual pledge in the future.
- It should be mentioned that the total cost of mission expenses should be increased by a reasonable amount. We would also like to mention that we receive non-monitory support from the local Churches such as providing us food and discounts from retreat Centers etc.
- ♣ No foreign donors or donation have been contributed towards the work of the Board for this year. It is a great achievement that the Board of Christian Education is totally dependent on local contributions.
- ♣ The Diocesan quota of LKR. 1,350,000/- helped to cover 80% of our administrative expenses. We appreciate the special donation that we received from the Diocese towards the publication of the Confirmation Books and for some events that we carried out just after the first wave of COVID 19.
- ♣ An annual budget was prepared and shared with the Mission Secretary and the Diocese.

Short Term

- ♣ We hope to reach our children through the virtual ministry via the video clips for the two age groups (ages 3-10 and 11-18)
- Introducing and implementing the Green Church concept with the help of the Sunday School Children.
- ♣ We look forward to work more closely with the Religious Education Board of the Diocese of Kurunegala.
- As we commemorate the 175th Anniversary of the Diocese of Colombo, we have planned to print a Children's Prayer Book in all three languages. We will be sharing it with the Children of our Diocese, the Diocese of Kurunegala and we hope to share some books with the other denominations which come under the National Christian Council as well.

Long Term

This year has been a very challenging year for the whole world and we are living in a rapidly changing world. Therefore we have to equip ourselves to work through virtual resources as well as making new arrangements to adjust with new norms. The Board has to work effectively and efficiently to bridge the gaps between on-sight and online education, and reschedule our programmes for children, teachers and parents for the moment. We have to publicize our virtual resources such as

the Webpage, YouTube channel, Facebook page and the educational links that we have available for the teachers.

Challenges

- Identifying new Resource Persons is a challenge.
- The data costs are high and some of the teachers and children are not equipped with Smart phones.
- To motivate teachers to get familiar with Social Medias and make them more tech friendly.
- We need to find foreign Donors to meet the demand that the Board of Christian Education has.

Auditors

We thank the Chairperson of the Aiyar & Company and Mr. Andrew Alex one of the Central Board members who personally undertook to complete the Accounts on time so that we were able to send it out to all our members two weeks before the Annual General Meeting.

Conclusion

We experienced the manifestation and guidance of God Almighty throughout the year. We experienced some unexpected situations such as cancelling the programmes, working from home, using new technology and social media, organizing meetings on Zoom etc. which gave us numerous new experiences. Some gave us additional stress and some experiences enriched us and strengthened and helped us to improve our weaknesses. OUR ACTIVITIES

2020

Due to the Covid 19 pandemic, we were unable to do take any other step. But we circulated the video clips sent by the Board of Christian Education to all the Sunday school children through the Sunday school teachers. Specially, in Kotagala the syllabus was sent to every child and was monitored by Sunday School Teachers.

January 2021

In the year 2021, we gathered St Paul's Talankande, St John's Lindula, All Saints' Agarapatana, All Saints' Maskeliya and St Margaret's Kotagala, for a retreat, to refresh the Sunday school with new mission.

March 2021

Lenten devotion for Sunday School Teachers was organized by the Board of Christian Education. Many teachers from the Up-country deanery participated.

May 2021

We conducted a one day program for the Sunday school teachers via Zoom, and we decided to conduct VBS for Sunday School Children through our deanery teachers. It was very successful. Most of the children participated. Teachers united via Zoom and organized it. We are still conducting the Sunday school lessons via Zoom.

SUGGESTIONS

Due to the current situation, we must be concerned about the children. I feel that we have unfortunately failed to look after our Sunday school children. When conducting the Sunday school through zoom, more than 40% of children are unable to participate. Some reasons are; they don't have the necessary technological facilities, network issues, due to these reasons they are unable to attend the online classes. It would be better if there was some other alternative solution in future.

Galle Deanery Report for the Year 2020/2021

Sunday School Ministry is happening in every church of the Galle Deanery. Due to the Pandemic situation of the country, the Sunday school ministry has presently stopped functioning. We circulate the video clips among the children which is sent by the Church of Ceylon Board of Christian Education.

Christ Church Hambanthota had conducted two programmes for the children of the Sunday school on "How to prevent Corona Virus" and another programme for the senior children of the Sunday school on "How important it is to live spiritual lives" They had to postpone one programme which was planned for the Sunday school Teachers.

Teacher training for the Sunday School Teachers of Church of the Divine Love Urubokka was conducted on Zoom. They had donated two crutches to two needy people on the 30th of May with the money collected by the Sunday school.

There was a Teacher Training Programme conducted by the Board of Christian Education for the Sunday School Teachers of the St. Luke's Church Deniyaya, Church of the divine Love Urubokka and Christ Church Beverly.

A separate training Programme for the Sunday School Teachers of the other churches of the Galle Deanery was held at Bournevista. This was organized by the Church of Ceylon Board of Christian Education. The opening session was conducted by the Ven. John Marshall Archdeacon of the Galle.

A one day Programme was held for the children of All Saints Church Galle, St. Anne's Church Kithulampitiya and Church of the Transfiguration Bournevista on the 27th of March 2021.

It is our pleasure to share that 4 Sunday school teachers from the Galle church sat for the NCRK examination held by the National Christian Council and got through the examination.

We appreciate all the commitment of the Priests and Sunday School Teachers and those who contribute tirelessly towards the Sunday School Ministry. We pray and ask God to give us blessings to start the Sunday Schools again.

Eastern Deanery Report for the Year 2020/2021

The Eastern Deanery consists of three districts namely the Trincomalee District, the Batticaloa District and the Ampara District.

There are two Churches in the Trincomalee district, five Churches and an Aims Center in the Batticaloa district, and there are two Churches and five Aims Centers in the Ampara district.

There are Tamil and Sinhala speaking students and teachers.

Even though classes have been held in recent years in the Churches, Classes could not be held properly due to the bomb blast in 2019 and the extraordinary situation of Covid19 beginning in 2020.

Though the Sunday school classes were not held properly for a few months in the year 2020, we were able to have a few classes according to the health guideline during the time when the Day Schools operated.

Christmas events took place.

Classes were held in the month of February 2021 with the Dedication Service of the teachers. However, since April classes have not been held due to the unavoidable situation.

But through the dedication of the teachers through the video clips released by the Board of Christian Education there were some activities carried among the children.

In October 2020, in the midst of a smooth situation in the country an event for children were held at the Batticaloa Kiran Ashram.

Problems encountered:

- 1. Most of the children and teachers do not have smart phone facilities.
- 2. As day School and Sunday school are not happening some children are abused and misused in various ways.
- 3. Family violence incidents have increased.

Future Programmes

- 1. Organizing awareness programs for Parents and children.
- 2. Increasing VBS events so that the children will be able to grow up in the Lord.
- 3. Enhancing training as a way to develop online teaching methods for teachers.
- 4. Conducting more drug prevention seminars for parents & children.
- 5. Conducting social and environmental awareness programs.
